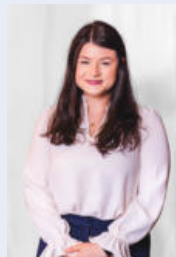

Which businesses are eligible to participate?

In order to participate, a business must be the following:

- Domiciled in Alabama
- Remain a member in good standing of their local chamber of commerce
- Local chamber of commerce must remain a member in good standing of the Chamber of Commerce Association of Alabama

Is there a minimum or maximum group size to participate?

Businesses must have at least 2 covered employees to participate. There is no maximum.

Can I work with my existing or local broker?

Yes, the broker must be a member of the local chamber of commerce. The broker should contact CCAAquotes@allainceplans.com.

Can a business sign up at any time?

Yes, a business can join their local chamber and sign up at any time throughout the year. For companies that already have existing benefits in place, they do not have to wait until their current renewal to participate in the program.
